
## Modern Markings


## **HOCKEY COMPETITION SURFACES**

There is one major change to how the modern competition surface in hockey is marked—management points for the corner (A) and penalty corner (B) are marked with descenders AWAY from the competition surface. If you are about to remark your hockey competition surface for the fall season, please consider making these improvements.



## **CORRECTING TWO COMMON ERRORS**

I. A growing number of competition surfaces are being marked with too many indicators (C) of the area outside the circle in which special management rules apply. Please limit the number of these markers to a total of 14 markings, each 2" wide and about 12" long.

**2.** Many colleges in the United States have marked their penalty corner management points (**B**) using 5 *yard* increments. Please note that the correct increment for colleges is 5 *meters*.
